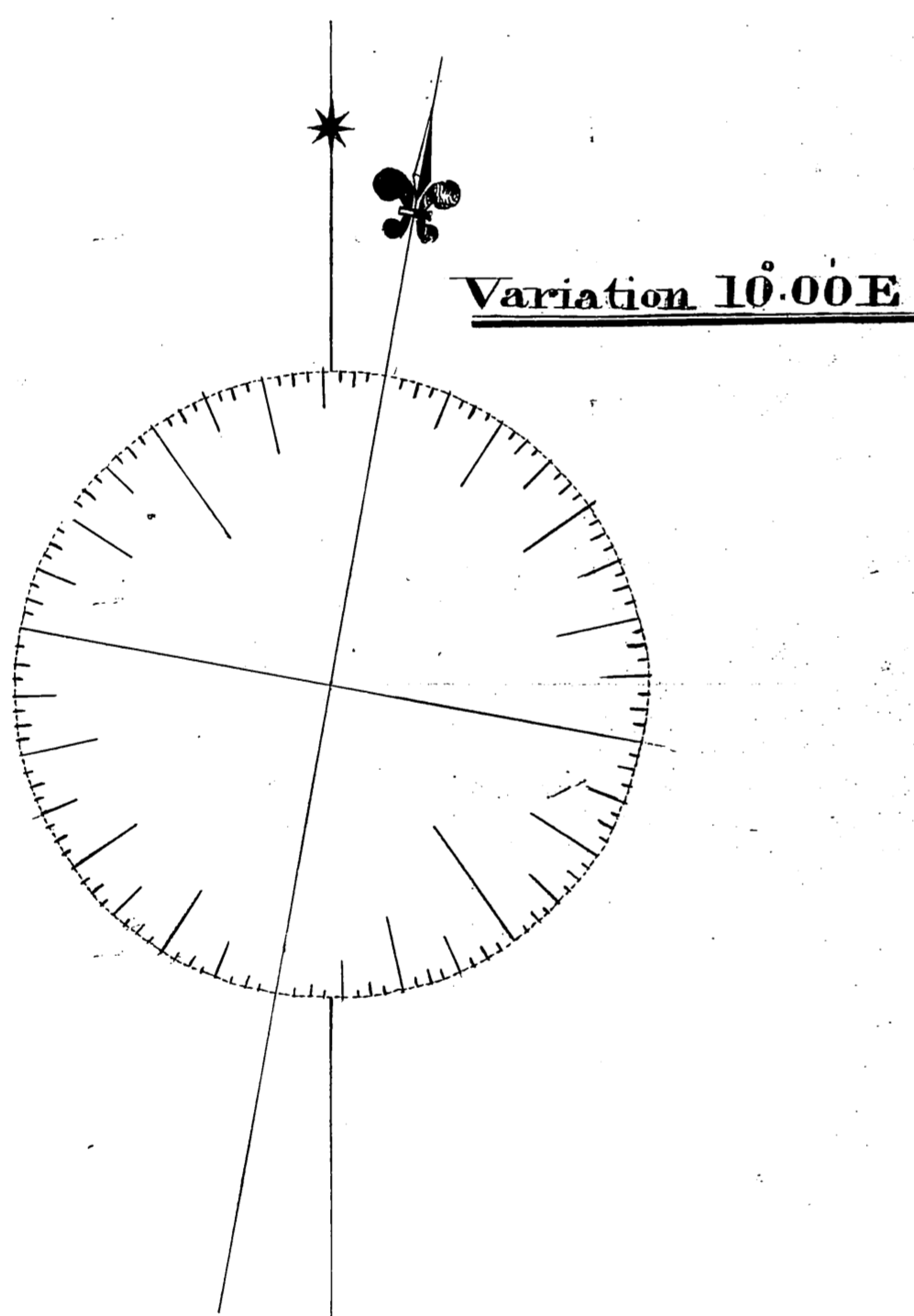

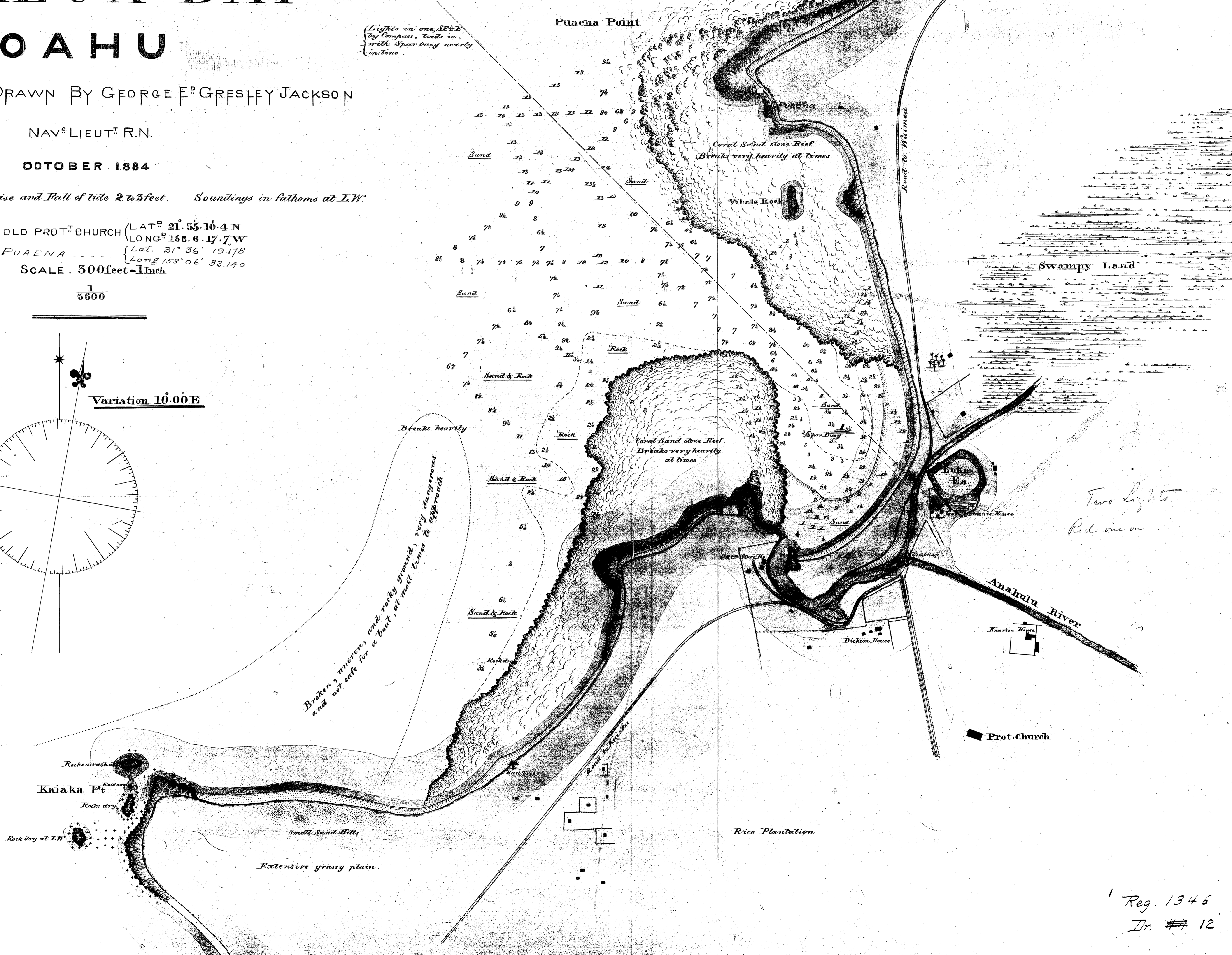
OLD PROT. CHURCH (LAT. 21° 55' 10.4" N
