The blue dotted line indicates approximately the boundary line on either side as awarded by the Commissioner in 1869.

The Magnetic Declination varies acc to locality from 8° E to 10° E.

Lines of Latitude and Longitude are as located by Govt Survey of 1873.

By an old map by A. Bishop the fishing right does not seem to have extended outside of Aiea Bay.

# AIEA.

## EWA, OAHU.

**DESCRIPTION.** From the makai end of the stone wall that separates the fish ponds known as Kūhāpūhāka and Kūlapeka run  $N. 77^{\circ} 18' E.$  true, 790 feet to the point marked B on the chart, said point B being marked by three buried stones marked respectively, A, H and I, the latter sign pointing to true North, and from said point B, the Government Survey signal on Salt Lake Hill bearing  $S. 67^{\circ} 44' E.$  true, distant 7392 feet, and running thence along  $N. 37^{\circ} 53' E.$  true (=  $48^{\circ} 10'$  magnetic) 3092 feet to a flat rock marked "MAMU", thence  $N. 60^{\circ} 33' E.$  true (=  $51^{\circ} 45'$  magnetic) 5190 feet to a peculiarly-pitted stone known as Pūhāhāhāwāwā; thence  $N. 54^{\circ} 38' E.$  true (=  $65^{\circ} 48'$  magnetic), 4858 feet to hill Pūhāhāka, mark a Maltese cross cut in the ground; thence along ridge  $N. 31^{\circ} 12' E.$  true, 4860 feet to point Kaulānākae, similarly marked; thence  $N. 54^{\circ} 30' E.$  true, 5330 feet to hill Kūhāhāka, the boundary being the watershed of the ridge skirting the valley of Kūhāhāka; thence  $N. 60^{\circ} 00' E.$  true, 1880 feet to the hill Ukae. The line following the ridge, and the azimuth and distance from Salt Lake Hill to Ukae being  $209^{\circ} 10'$ , 17689 feet, thence down the watershed of ridge skirting valley of Kūhāhāka to point marked "u" on chart, the direct bearing & distance being  $S. 71^{\circ} 28' W.$  8360 feet; thence along Kūhāhāka,  $S. 56^{\circ} 04' W.$  true, 11510 feet, to flat rock split thru center, marked "B & H" at S. corner of Capt. Keolu land, thence along Dr. J. S. McGrew's lands Paiaian and Kōpuaia,  $S. 50^{\circ} 08' W.$  true, 1600 feet to a point on the seashore which is  $N. 82^{\circ} 45' W.$  1768 ft from "u", thence along high water mark and fish pond wall to starting point. Area, 1125 Acres.
