Notes of Survey

Commencing at Sea coast at an Ahu, line of Anachoomalu & running to Keahu a lono N 79.23° W 20.00 chains, thence along Waikoloa as follows; N 89° E. 522.00 chains, passing Puuho, Palihai Hanamauloa, Kaula, Kahialaa, Kapalihookaaka to Kapukaiki; S 47° E. 89.00 chains to an Ahu; S 36° E. 65.00 chains to Kikiha; S 53° E. 136.00 chains to cave of Hanaiiali; S 42° E. 82.00 chains to waawakea; S 53° E. 73.00 chains to Ahu; S 65° E. 73.00 chains to Keramuku; S 58° E. 162.00 chains to Hewia; S 55° E. 72.00 chains to Ahu; S 62° E. 160.00 chains to Keawa; S 58° E. 194.00 chains to Puukapala on Western Slope, thence along Kaohi S 25° W. 613.00 chains to large Ahu on aa of 1859 at place called Puukapala thence to corner on Keaahu; thence along line of Kaupulehu to Pohakunahana, N 74° W. 613.00 chains; thence along line of Puuwaawaa, N 11° W 155.00 chains to Ana o Maui a sleeping cave; N 31° W. 260.00 chains to point on aa opposite Puukapala; N 34° W 130.00 chains to an Ahu on aa; N 29° W 60.00 chains to an Ahu on aa; N 58° W. 37.00 chains; N 21° W. 34.00 chains to Ahuakamali; N 51° 31' W. 129.50 chains to Ahu on Hill near flow of 1859; N 50° W. 182.50 chains to pond at Keaahu on the sea coast; thence along sea coast N 26° 15' E. 150.00 chains to Ahu at point of Commencement & containing an Area of 86,945.00 Acres more or less.

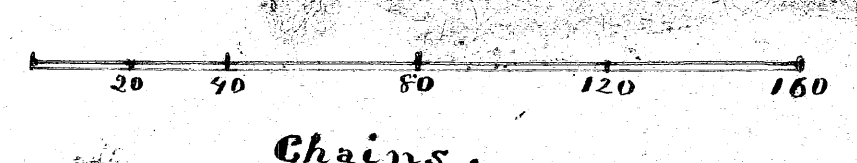
